New Business:

<u>Plaintiffs</u> for the <u>lawsuit</u> – Casey has informed the Board that anyone who rented their home/s during the time frame named in the suit can be listed as plaintiff in the suit. CCA needs 10 - 12 volunteers to be named a s plaintiff in the suit.

<u>Life Guard Contract</u> – The BOC tabled approval on the Life Guard Contract for next year. The County is considering taking over the contract. It appears to be another move toward unified government.

<u>New Building Projects</u> – The County has several new building projects without presenting them to the public.

<u>BOC members</u> – Bob White was named as new Chairman and Mike Payment was named Vice Chairman. No one has been appointed to replace Bobby Hanig, there are two people interested. The two newly elected members are Kevin McCord and Owen Ethridge.
