Guest Speakers: Towne Bank – Keith Horton, Sr. EVP & Chief Facilities Director, and Taylor Sugg, Regional President; and Clark Twiddy, President Twiddy & Co.

- All very supportive of CCA's efforts to establish a year-round health services center in Corolla
- Corolla Towne Bank facility in Corolla to be closed once their new branch in Duck is opened in the fall
- Corolla Towne Bank facility could be a site for the Health Center, but other options also available
- Questions and concerns from the audience about how Corolla residents and businesses could be better served, especially during the summer, if the branch closes
- Asking if ATM machine could remain at the current facility or moved to Food Lion, etc.
- Concerns about local businesses who need change and small bills
- Towne outlined some options they have used elsewhere & things they could do to meet community's needs

- County has filed a partial motion to dismiss, scheduled for December hearing.
