

Corolla Wish List

Compiled from comments from citizens in Corolla.

Corolla Village Issues

- Declare a moratorium on projects in Corolla Village until small area plan complete.
- Preserve the historical architectural configuration of Old Corolla Village.
- Respect existing natural resources.
- Complete and implement the Small Area Plan.

Planning Considerations

- The County must seek input from Corolla and the northern beaches and coordinate the multiple planning efforts that are underway which effect Corolla and the northern Currituck County beaches.
- Develop and implement master plan for the Currituck County Outer Banks that addresses current and future needs to support the residents and visitors.
- Accelerate the UDO re-write.
- Review and use as a planning framework the results of the Economic Development Advisory Boards Currituck Outer Banks Visioning effort.

Infrastructure / Tourist Support

- Complete the bike path along Rt. 12.
- Complete the waster water management project.
- Reevaluate the Mid County Bridge proposal.
- Prepare for the Mid County Bridge.
- Construct restrooms, parking and changing facilities at Lighthouse drive.
- Plan for and provide affordable potable water for the Currituck Outer Banks.

Local Fulltime Resident Support

- Support a school in Corolla.
- Consider establishing a public maritime transportation system to facilitate movement from the mainland to Corolla.

- Build a community and recreation center for the Currituck Outer Banks community.

Natural Resource Preservation

- Preserve green spaces and seek a Dark Sky Community designation.
- Continue to support the wild horse herd and work to develop approaches to preserve the herd even with or without the Mid County Bridge.
- Limit Access to Northern Beaches
- Enhance the Clean Beach Policy enforcement.

Governance

- Provide telecommunications capabilities so that residents can attend County meetings remotely.
- Enhance the communication capabilities of the County website.
- Provide public transportation for Currituck Outer Banks residents to the Currituck Mainland for access to the YMCA, County offices, etc.
- Provide the Currituck Outer Banks community with an opportunity to determine the priorities for the uses of the occupancy tax revenue on an annual basis prior to establishing the budget.
 - Suggested occupancy tax uses:
 - Library funding
 - Community Center
